

VILLAGE OF NORTH CHEVY CHASE
Council Meeting
February 20, 2007

The meeting was called to order by Chairwoman, Shannon Dorman at 8:03 pm. Also present were Bob Weesner, Jim Grissom, Ambrose Liao, Adrian Andreassi and Nate Spiller; and other residents of the Village (list attached).

Secretary's Report – approved secretary's report for January, 2007 without objection.

Treasurer's Report – Reviewed treasurer's report for January, 2007. Approved without objection. The final budget will be submitted at the April meeting. Also discussed buying street lights and the lighting bill.

New Business:

1. Permit for addition at 3809 Jones Bridge Road. Permit and drawings were presented. This is an addition on back of house. There are no setback issues, not height issues. Approved without objection.
2. Permit for addition at 8904 Clifford Ave. New drawings were presented. Previously had preliminary designs. Changed design to be in footprint of existing garage with master bedroom over and deeper into back yard. Approved without objection pending county permit.
3. Permit for a fence at 3701 Jones Bridge Road. Permit/application not ready at this time. Did not vote.
4. E-Connection for Village of North Chevy Chase. Ambrose Liao to help Bob Weesner set up list serve for NCC. Discussed using Beacon Hill Concierge Service as model. Will start list serve as an "announcement only" service and have villagers email village with content.
5. FY2008 Budget. Discussed briefly during Treasurer's Report. Final budget will be submitted at the April meeting.
6. Nominating Committee. Need a nominating committee for nominating candidates for opening positions. Village Council will ask last year's committee if they are interested. Consider Cynthia Sexton as an alternate.

Unfinished Business

1. Mansionization. No new news.
2. Neighborhood Watch. Bob Weesner has been going to meetings. 3 representatives from NCC attended last meeting.

Other Business:

1. Mr. Lambros's car was damaged by contractors working on Village Property. The contractor's insurance company denied reimbursement for claim. Forwarded insurance claim, estimates, ... to contractor. Village of NCC withheld the cost

- from last payment to contractor. The village will give check to Mr. Lambros if no further action from contractor.
2. Discussed supporting the effort of other municipalities to pass legislation pertaining to street lights.
 3. Discussed snow removal. Several villagers expressed dissatisfaction with snow removal. Primary complaint: never saw contractor out working, no sand/salt, not plowed to sides of streets. In defense of contractor, Bob Weesner saw them out on several occasions.
