Annual Meeting: The Annual Meeting of the Village is scheduled for **Tuesday, May 1st** at the Youth Lounge, North Chevy Chase Christian Church at 8:00 PM. The Annual Meeting will be preceded by a short business meeting at 7:30 PM.

Nominating Committee: The Village has appointed a Nominating Committee of Jim Lambros, Anne Cantrel and Mana McNeill. Two seats on the Village Council and one seat on the Fire Board will expire this year. There will be two vacancies on the Council. Any qualified Village voter interested in serving or

recommending someone to serve on the Council may contact a member of the Committee.

Village Elections: Village residents who are eligible to vote in Montgomery County elections are automatically eligible to vote in Village elections. Voters who have registered with the County need not re-register to vote in the Village election. However, residents who have not registered will need to show proof of residence to vote. Absentee ballots are available by calling the Village Office by April 21.

Budget for 2007-2008: The Village Council is in the process of finalizing the Operating and Capital Budgets for Fiscal Year 2008. Copies of the proposed budget are attached. Please e-mail (nccvm@comcast.net) the Village Manager or talk with any of the Council Members if you have budget items to consider.
