Permits granted: The following permits were granted at the Village Council Meeting on February 21, 2006:

- Permit to construct a fence at 3711 Jones Bridge Road
- Permit to construct a fence at 3708 Kenilworth Driveway
- Permit to construct a portico at 9005 Kensington Parkway

Bulk Trash Pick-up will be on Saturday, March 18th: Items must be curbside by 9 a.m. Our contractor uses different trucks to haul different items so do not be alarmed if certain items are removed before others. Please contact You Call We Haul, Inc., at 301-605-0140 if you wish to dispose of a refrigerator, freezer or air conditioner.

Bulk trash includes: Washing machines, dryers, stoves, hot water heaters, other major appliances; furniture or parts of furniture, large toys, bicycles, swing sets, bath tubs, sinks, toilets; do-it-yourself amounts of earth, sand, gravel, demolition debris and construction waste; parts of automobiles (but not fleet tires)

Excluded are: Large tree stumps, poisons, acids caustics, explosives, oil or other flammable liquids, motors vehicles and parts including batteries and tires, bricks and general construction material, iron pipe over 10 feet long, large rocks, wood piles, large tree limbs, dead

animals, human or animal feces and ammunition.

Nominating Committee: The Village has appointed a Nominating Committee of Demetrios Lambros, Mana McNeill and Ann Cohen. Four seats on the Village Council and one seat on the Fire Board will expire this year. Any qualified Village voter interested in serving or recommending someone to serve on the Council or Fire Board may contact a member of the Committee.
