Permits Granted:

The following permits were granted at the November 14 meeting of the Village Council:

Erect a fence at 3602 Stewart Driveway.

Bulk Trash Pick-up: The next bulk trash pickup is scheduled for December 16th beginning at 9 AM.

Our contractor uses different trucks to haul different items, so do not be

alarmed if certain items are removed before others. Please contact Montgomery County Sanitation at 301-605-0140 if you wish to dispose of a refrigerator, freezer or air conditioner. Bulk trash includes washing machines, dryers, stoves, hot water heaters, other major appliances, furniture or parts of furniture, large toys, bicycles, swing sets, bath tubs, sinks, toilets, do-it-yourself amounts of earth, sand, gravel, demolition debris and construction waste and parts of automobiles (but not fleet tires).

Excluded are large tree stumps, poisons, acids, caustics, explosives, oil or other flammable liquids, motor vehicles and parts including batteries and tires, bricks and general construction material, iron pipes over ten feet long, large rocks, wood piles, large tree limbs, dead animals, human or animal feces and ammunition.

Village Permits: Village permits are required for additions or alterations to existing structures and new construction as well as for the replacement or erection of fences. Please refer to the Village Regulations for details or contact the Village Office at 301-654-7084. A copy of the Village Regulations and Permit forms are available on the Village website at www.northchevyCHASE.org.

Leaf Collection: Weekly curbside collection of leaves began the week of October 16th and will continue through December 31st. Leaf collection is scheduled for Mondays each week, weather permitting. Leaves are not to be shredded. Sticks, rocks and other debris are not collectible and should not be mixed in the leaf pile.

New 2007 Directory: It is time to begin work on the 2007 Village Directory. If you are new to North Chevy Chase or if you wish to add to or change your family's entry, please call the Village Office or send an e-mail with the desired new information. The Village is considering adding **DOGS NAMES** to the directory this year (*in italics to avoid confusing with children*).

Snow Reminder: When snow is expected, please park in your driveway or on the **even-numbered** side of the street only. Please shovel or sand, as needed, any sidewalk abutting your property.

If you would like to request that a Village tree be considered for pruning, please call or e-mail the Village Office with the location of the tree. All Village trees are listed on the Village website. Also, ivy climbing up tree trunks presents a danger to trees. It is recommended that the ivy root system be cut. The ivy will then die and will be easier to remove.
