## Monthly Council Meeting – Tuesday, June 16, 8:00pm

Meeting was called to order at 8:05pm by Adrian Andreassi. Also present were Brigitte Akalovsky, John Spain, Bob Weesner, Bruce Cohen and other residents of the Village (list attached).

**Secretary's Report for May** – Approved secretary's report without objection.

**Treasurer's Report for May** – Treasurer's report approved without objection.

### New Business:

1. *Permit to erect a wall at 3605 Husted Driveway* – Approved without objection – no county permit needed.
2. *Permit to erect a fence at 3607 Husted Driveway.* – Approved by the Council. County permit already secured.
3. *Permit to erect an addition at 3817 Kenilworth Driveway* – Approved, pending issuance of County permit.
4. *Forth of July Picnic* – The event will be virtually unchanged from the 2008 edition. No porta-potties will be secured, as the Houlihans have kindly offered their home for restroom use. The food order from Famous Dave will cost the Village \$50 more, and once again the event will feature keg beer, wine, lemonade and water. Bob Weesner will provide tables for a picnic that will accommodate an expected 150 people. An announcement will be made via fliers and the Village ListServe.

### Unfinished Business:

1. *Village sign / seal* – Larger sign template to finalized / painted by Bob Weesner and then reviewed by the Council for consideration as the final product.
2. *Speed cameras* – Street monitors have been in place and measuring vehicle speed in front of NCC ES on Jones Bridge Road since the first week of June. County is already addressing concerns of speeding out-of-service Ride On buses. Analysis will consider the fall off in traffic due to school dismissal for the summer.
3. *Street paving* – The 3600 blocks of Husted, Inverness, Kenilworth and Dundee are the streets with the greatest wear and most need for paving. Still awaiting unit and “all-in” pricing options from paving contractors that are key for a decision.
4. *BRAC Task Force* – Next meeting will be June 30<sup>th</sup> – Brigitte Akalovsky will obtain location details and Council will send representation.
