

**VILLAGE OF NORTH CHEVY CHASE**  
**Council Meeting**  
**February 21, 2006**

The meeting was called to order by Chairwoman, Anne Cantrel at 8:05 pm. Also present were Bob Weesner, Jim Grissom, Cynthia Sexton, Shannon Dorman and Nate Spiller; and other residents of the Village (list attached).

**Secretary's Report** - The report for January, 2006 was approved without objections. Will make noted changes to January minutes.

**Treasurer's Report** – The report for January, 2006 was approved without objections.

**New Business:**

1. Permit to construct an addition at 9005 Kensington Parkway. Architect represented home owners. The Council reviewed plans. There are no set back or other issues. Permit was approved without objection.
2. Permit to construct a fence at 3711 Jones Bridge Road. Replacing wood portion of wall/fence. Approved without objection.
3. Permit to construct a fence at 3708 Kenilworth Driveway. Front fence proposed. Has been suggested to owner to set fence back 1 foot from sidewalk in case of any future widening of sidewalks. Will measure setback from center of road. Approve permit contingent upon village manager measuring setback from center of road. Fence is to be constructed at the property line or 1 foot back from the sidewalk, which ever is greater.
4. Council to appoint a Nominating Committee for the May Election. Mr. Lambros was assigned (and accepted) to the committee. Also considered are Mana McNeill and Ann Cohen. Will follow up with potential members. Will announce nominating committee in newsletter.
5. Lawn and landscaping contract. Renewing Dan's lawn and landscaping service. Approved without objection.
6. Diverter repair. Do not have a price yet. Curbing around diverters needs repairs. WSSC will be doing work in the area. Will try to get a price from WSSC's contractor to do work at the same time.

**Unfinished Business:**

1. Construction update. Verizon digging in the neighborhood for new fiber optic cable. WSSC fixed water main break at Inverness. Making individual house tie-ins. Some of the connections are 7 feet below grade (rather than 4). Will make repairs after all houses are connected. May end up having the road repaved by WSSC. Next road on the list is Kenilworth.

**Other Business:**

Bob spoke with Bethesda police. Explained the measures we've taken to control speed on Kensington Pkwy and that people are still speeding down the middle. They will put us on their watch list and start ticketing.

Discussed possibility of having WIFI offered by village.

The Council wants to extend their appreciation to Mana McNeil for all her hard work on the council.
